

ACT® Prep Workshop

Workshop Details Policies

Workshop: This 16-hour workshop is available to students from any school and offers comprehensive preparation for the ACT. Participants will review core subject material while also learning effective test-taking strategies tailored specifically to the ACT. Instructors will cover the various question types found on the exam, techniques for tackling challenging questions, and strategies for managing time under pressure.

During the school year, the workshops consist of 4 Saturdays leading up to an ACT Test date. During the summer, workshops are often 4 consecutive days leading up to an ACT summer test date. Follow us on Facebook or join our email list to be notified when the next workshop is. Workshops are held from 10 AM to 3 PM each day, with a lunch break from 12:00-1:00.

Instructors: Kelly Walden (M.A.) is our English/reading teacher. Kelly has been teaching ACT prep for over 20 years. Kaylin Mannon (M.Ed.) is our math teacher. Kaylin is a certified high school teacher who is currently a stay-at-home mom.

Location: Workshops are often held in the Reidland Church Annex, 5500 Kentucky Dam Road, Paducah, KY 42003. But if the Annex is in use, we will notify all who signed up in advance.

Cost: We charge \$300 for the workshop. You are able to pay by cash, check (made out to Kaylin Mannon), or Venmo (@Kaylin-Mannon) on the first day of the workshop.

We do offer discounts – including a sibling discount (\$50 off if you've had a sibling take the workshop before) and a referral discount (\$50 discount if a friend mentions your name when registering). Scholarships are also available by counselor referral.

If a student misses one of the workshop days, there are two options: make up the day at a later workshop for free or pay for private tutoring to cover the missed material. The private tutoring is \$65 an hour.
